(TDAG), 24-28 May 2021

Dear Sir/Madam,

It is my great pleasure to invite you to participate in the 28th meeting of the Telecommunication Development Advisory Group (TDAG), to be held online, from 24 to 28 May 2021.

In view of the continued prevalence of the COVID-19 pandemic, the meeting of TDAG will be held virtually for the second year in a row. The meeting will be limited to three hours per day (2 hours on 24 May 2021) to minimize the disturbance to participants from all time zones.

This meeting of TDAG is the last one before the next World Telecommunication Development Conference (WTDC-21) that will take place in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, from 8 to 19 November 2021. Its agenda has been adapted to cover all key issues that require discussions prior to WTDC-21. TDAG-21 will take stock of the regional preparations for WTDC-21, consider the outcomes of the TDAG working groups and discuss relevant issues highlighted during the two Inter-Regional Meetings that will have taken place before TDAG-21.

Information on submission of contributions, registration and other logistics for TDAG-21

Registration, access and participation

Registration for TDAG-21 will be carried out exclusively online and is already open.

Each delegate interested in attending the meeting should complete and submit a <u>registration form that can</u> be accessed here.

Delegates can register for the meeting using their ITU user account credentials (i.e. username and password). In case they do not have an ITU user account, they can create one by following the steps available HERE.. A User account with TIES access allows delegates to access ITU information resources including contributions and other working documents.

Note: For delegates who already created their user account when registering to previous events on this same system can still use the same account.

All registration requests for participation in TDAG-21 must be **validated by the Designated Focal Points** (**DFPs**) of administrations and entities entitled to participate. The list of Designated Focal Points is available <u>HERE</u>. To modify the contact details of a Designated Focal Point or to change the Designated Focal Point, an official letter from an authorized official should be sent to the BDT Meetings Registration Service (by e-mail to: bdtmeetingsregistration@itu.int), providing the new DFP's last name, first name and e-mail address.

Membership is encouraged to consider gender balance when deciding their delegations to TDAG-21. Furthermore, more than one person can participate from an organization/country.

Interpretation

Interpretation in the six ITU official languages will be provided for TDAG-21.

Access to the virtual meeting room and captioning

Information to access the virtual meeting room will be provided to duly registered participants through a separate email.

Only those participants duly registered for the meeting will be able to access the virtual meeting room.

The standard captioning service will be provided through the virtual meeting room. For those participants wishing to access the captioning script directly, the link will be available at the TDAG-21 website.

Contributions to TDAG

As per WTDC Resolution 1 (Rev. Buenos Aires, 2017), contributions from membership should not exceed five pages and must be submitted using the online template available at the <u>TDAG-21 website</u>.

Please attach the original "Word" version of your contribution to the online submission form to ensure that all hyperlinks, graphics and tables are correctly displayed.

In accordance with provision 13.2.2 of WTDC Resolution 1, contributions for TDAG must be received no later than 45 calendar days before the start of the event, that is by **10 April 2021 (2359 hours, Geneva time)**, in order to be translated for the meeting.

Contributions that do not meet this 45-day deadline but are received at least 12 calendar days before the opening of the meeting (i.e., by 13 May 2021) shall be published but not translated.

Contributions received less than 12 calendar days before the meeting shall not be included on the agenda.

Documentation

All documents will be posted on the <u>TDAG-21 website</u>.

Delegates are asked to ensure that they have TIES access rights to be able to access the documents for the TDAG meeting through the website. Information on how to request TIES access rights can be found at http://www.itu.int/TIES/.
