Passports & visas

To enter Brazil, you need a valid passport, as well as a completed entry and exit card. This document must be kept with the traveler, and if he leaves Brazil, it will be collected by the Federal Police. This document is provided by the airlines.

Other documents are required under specific conditions.

- Resident foreigners (temporary or permanent): together with the passport, you must have the foreigner's identity card, or a request for regularization by the Federal Police.
- Mercosur foreigners: you only need the identity document along with the passport. Registration with the Federal Police is not required for tourism, sporting and artistic activities, and business purposes.
- Foreigners traveling to Brazil: finally, for tourism or permanent trips, a visa from the country of origin is required. In countries that do not require a visa from Brazilians to enter, there is reciprocity of access.

Health insurance

The unlikely event of illness or injury, delegates will be responsible for costs incurred during Brazilian medical assistance. Delegates should consider taking out travel insurance before departing for Brazil and ensure that they have an adequate level of travel insurance to cover their stay in Brazil.

Currencies and Banks

- The official currency of Brazil is the Brazilian real (BRL).
- The official exchange rate fluctuates daily depending on the exchange market. Currency changes can be made in banks or authorized exchange houses in airports and hotels. The Brazilian real is the official currency since 1994.
- Banks work between 11:00 and 16:00 on weekdays. Foreign currencies and traveler's checks can be exchanged for "Reais" at some banks in Brasilia (Banco do Brasil, Banco Central, Banco de Boston and Citibank). It is recommended to use the "Banco do Brasil" to withdraw money or exchange it at its agencies are located in the international airports of Rio de Janeiro, São Paulo and Brasilia.
- Credit cards (VISA, MasterCard, American Express, and Diners Club) are generally accepted at hotels, department stores, and restaurants.



Official Language

In Brazil, the official language is Brazilian Portuguese.

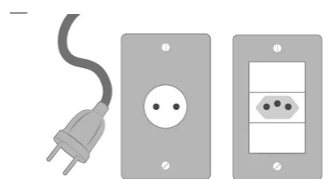

Helpful Tips

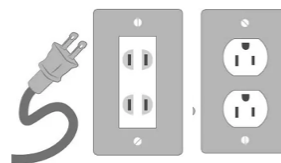
- TIME ZONE: Brasília Time = BRT (UTC-3).
- TIPS: Tipping is not common in Brazil unlike other parts of the world. Normally, the tip is 10% of the addition and is already included in the bill. Even so, the customer has the right not to pay it.
- TRANSPORTATION: Distances in Brasília are long, but for that the city has a taxi service and transportation apps (Uber, 99 and Cabify). Taxis in Brasília are white with a yellow and green sign of the Federal District Government (GDF). The starting price of the race is R\$ 5.24, flag 1 (during the day) costs R\$ 2.85 per kilometer and flag 2 (during the night), R\$ 3.66 per kilometer.
- SHOPPING: For the convenience of the delegates, near ANATEL there are streets with restaurants, shops, supermarket and bank.
- Depending on the destination city, the type of outlet and voltage may change.
- In Brasília, Voltage is 220v and frequency is 60 Hz.
- Type C Plug: This one only function with type C or N socket (more common).
- Type A Plug: This one only function with type B socket.
