

# **LOGISTICS INFORMATION**

### **HONDURAS**

Honduras, in the heart of Central America, is a mountainous Latin republic of 8.1 million

inhabitants, which works for its national development in various sectors: agricultural production, especially coffee, one of the best in the world, and bananas, the of manufacturing and maquila, the conservation of its generously rich biodiversity and the organic growth of tourism as a focus of community development.



80% of its territory is mountainous and it has 107 protected natural areas, including the second largest rain forest in the Americas, after the Amazon, and the second largest coral reef in the world, the Mesoamerican Reef.

A great diversity of flora, fauna and underwater life, history, archaeological sites, including the most important ceremonial center of the Mayan classic period, diving paradises, Caribbean beaches reviewed by the main specialized media in the world and diverse ways of being and living together in their different regions, waiting to discover what no one but you can experience.

### CLIMATE

Honduras is located in a tropical position 15 to 16 degrees north of the equator, it only has two seasons, which are well defined: the dry season and the rainy season.

The rainy season begins in May and extends until July with a break during the month of August, it generally resumes in September until November when the dry season begins. Like much of central Honduras, the city of Tegucigalpa has a tropical climate, although tempered by altitude, meaning less humid than the lower valleys and coastal regions. It has two seasons, the dry and cold season that begins in November and ends in March and the rainy and warm season that begins in April and ends in October.

### **CURRENCY**

The Lempira is the monetary unit of Honduras since 1931. Bills of 1, 2, 5, 10, 20, 50, 200, 100 and 500 Lempiras circulate.

The Lempiras exchange rate is variable daily and is controlled by the Central Bank of Honduras, as of July 31, 2022, the average lempiras vs. dollar rate is 24.61165 lempiras per dollar.

### **TELEPHONY**

The country code is 504, fixed telephony is managed by HONDUTEL, a state company, and mobile telephony is provided by the companies TIGO and CLARO, who offer roaming services to other regional and global companies. International calls use the code +00.



### TRANSPORT

Honduras has more than 15,400 km of highways, the country's main highway runs from Puerto Cortés in the Caribbean, passing through San Pedro Sula, Comayagüela, Tegucigalpa. Until reaching Nacaome and Choluteca in the south of the country, where the Pan-American highway also crosses.

Honduras has 6 seaports: Puerto Cortés, Puerto Castilla, La Ceiba, Roatán and Tela, which are located in the North of the Country with access to the Atlantic Ocean and in the South with access; to the Pacific Ocean only the port of Bocas del Henecán or San Lorenzo. Puerto Cortés is the most important in the country and together with Puerto Caja and San Lorenzo, they handle almost all of Honduras' maritime trade. The ports of La Ceiba, Roatán and Tela specialize in tourism, every week they are visited by international cruise ships with the capacity to transport between 400 and 800 international tourists.

Currently, the country has three international airports:

- International Airport Palmerola (XPL)
- International Airport Toncontin (TGU) Comayagüela
- International Airport Ramón Villeda Morales (SAP) San Pedro Sula

# **ELECTRICITY AND TELEPHONY**

The voltage in Honduras is 110 Volts. Standard 2-pin grounded plugs are generally available. Take this into account to take a suitable adapter with you if necessary.



The international telephone code of Honduras is +504

Mobile phone operators are CLARO y TIGO.
