- Inaugural Summit, London – 10-11th December 2014
- 50 governments and international organisations
- 26 leading technology companies
- 10 civil society organisations
- Baroness Joanna Shields appointed as UK Minister for Internet Safety and Security

- 2nd Summit, Abu Dhabi – 16-17th November 2015

#WePROTECT



Some key points:

- This is a truly global challenge. A growing and heinous crime on an “industrial scale.
- CSAM search term and autofill interrupt: Blocking Google has seen five-fold reduction in search
- Peer to peer and TOR are the new frontier: proactive pursuit
- Capacity building, particularly around law enforcement and legislation will be key.

#WePROTECT



- New UK law making it illegal for an adult to send sexual communication to a child
- £50 million pledge over five years. This newly established global child protection fund is administered by UNICEF.
- Extra £10 million to create further specialist online child sexual abuse teams in NCA
- Joint NCA and GCHQ team to share expertise
- Establishment of single Child Abuse Image Database (CAID) of indecent images of children.

#WePROTECT



- International Advisory Board established
- Three working groups – government, industry, NGOs
- Proposed Model National Response – 17 countries selected
- Abu Dhabi Summit will seek to broaden engagement and propose a Statement of Action.
