March and April Web Dialogue Outcomes

The deliberations at the web dialogues were collated into three high level concepts for WTDC preparations, submitted by the BDT Director to TDAG-20

1. Preparatory Process

- a. Comprehensive preparatory process that includes a non-binding Inter-Regional coordination meetings (IRMs) with clear format, agenda
- b. Representation in IRMs with co-ordination between RPMs and RTOs
- c. Coordination on conference theme
- d. Leverage on selected high profile events to promote WTDC

2. During the Conference

a. Merge high level segment and side events into thematic events (development track)

3. Strategic Plan

a. WTDC would not discuss the ITU-D Contribution to ITU Strategic Plan in detail. The Strategic Plan would be addressed by a TDAG Group.


- ☐ Review WTDC preliminary proposals on WTDC-21 preparatory process;
- ☐ In consultation with ITU membership and the TDAG Bureau, make recommendations for arrangements with preparatory meetings and events prior to the conference;
- Develop proposals and make recommendations that might enhance the arrangements for the conference, including:
 - Conference content;
 - Determination of conference theme(s);
 - Consider the Thematic tracks;
 - Key Stakeholders

WTDC Preparations

TDAG-WG-Prep – Update



Addition of a new, 2-3 day, Development/Partnership Segment or track with expanded participation, more interactive sessions, and delivering concrete development outputs





Development/Partnership segment should incorporate the HL segment with changes to the approach to policy statements



Working Group recommends a minimum of two and a maximum of three Inter-regional Meetings, to be held back-to-back with RPMs



To be finalised at meeting on 4 November 2020

TDAG-WG-Prep – Schedule



- Second meeting of TDAG-WG-Prep was held on 7 September 2020, 5 contributions were made (Russian Federation, Indonesia, ESOA, Lithuania and Zimbabwe)
- Third Meeting was held on 30 September 2020, three contributions were made (Argentine, Brazil, Canada and USA) as well as a Temporary Document comprising a Secretariat Concept Note
- Fourth meeting held on 20 October 2020, and continued on 4 November 2020
- Final report will be published by 6 November 2020 and will be submitted to TDAG 2020/3 on 23 November 2020



WTDC-21 Preparation Process – TDAG-WG-RDTP

Working Group on Resolutions, Declaration and Thematic Priorities (TDAG-WG-RDTP)

Chair – Dr. Ahmad Sharafat, Iran

- Review WTDC resolutions, examine their number and subject matter, and consider streamlining, to avoid repetitions and duplication with the Resolutions of the Plenipotentiary Conference.
- Align the ITU-D thematic priorities, proposed regional initiatives and proposed study group questions;
- Propose elements and make recommendations to ITU membership for the future draft Declaration;
- Report its outcomes to TDAG.

WTDC Preparations TDAG-WG-RDTP – Update



Just concluded under the Fourth Block of meetings the last meeting of WG-RDTP before the extra-ordinary session of TDAG



Discussions were on Streamlining Resolutions, the Declaration, and Thematic Priorities



Two Liaison Statements were received from the two Chairs of ITU-D Study Group 1 and 2, and the TDAG Working Group on Strategies and Operations Plans



The WG-RDTP Chair submitted three documents with annexes on the three topics (Resolutions, Declaration, and Thematic Topics.



The Report coming out of the meeting held on 21 October 2020, will now be submitted to TDAG by the Chair of the Working Group

Chair - Dr. Blanca Gonzales, Spain

- To review the Strategic Plan and to prepare proposals for the draft new ITU-D contribution to the Strategic Plan for the next period (2024-2027).
- To review the status of implementation and impact of the Buenos Aires action plan and its links with the Operational Plan.
- To review the status of implementation and impact of the four-year rolling Operational Plan, identify areas of improvement, and develop recommendations for the Draft Operational Plan prior to consideration by Council.
- Outcomes to WTDC-21

TDAG-WG-SOP – Framing Questions

Review of Strategic Plan, Buenos Aires Action Plan and 4-year rolling plan



- 1. Where has BDT excelled in building on the "One-ITU" framework, and where is there need for improvement?
- 2. How well is BDT on track quantitatively meeting objective targets?
- 3. Which adjustments are recommended to better align with the strategy?
- 4. What are the recommendations to reduce duplication with other Sectors?
- 5. How should we coordinate with TDAG-WG-Prep to align our position on regional initiatives?

TDAG-WG-SOP – Framing Questions

Proposals for ITU-D contribution to ITU strategic plan (2024-27) and draft Operational Plan




- 1. What products and services portfolio will help us attract and retain partners, and which organizations should be targeted for cooperation?
- 2. How should BDT streamline, consolidate and prioritize its offering?
- 3. What competition is expected and how should BDT adapt strategically for a competitive advantage in this environment?
- 4. What specific objectives, outcomes and outputs should be envisioned?

WTDC Preparations TDAG-WG-SOP – Update

- 1. One contribution (Mexico/Canada/USA) on Procedure proposing modifications to Resolutions 1 and 24 supported by TDAG-WG-SOP;
- Liaison statements on the above provided to TDAG-WG-PREP and TDAG-WG-RDTP;
- Agreement on prioritization of the Goals and ITU-D Objectives (poll outcome) towards the new Strategic Operational Plan and Action Plan; and
- 4. Contribution questions and framing questions provided to TDAG for discussion.

- Second Meeting was held on 1 October 2020, one contribution received (USA) and various secretariat presentations made on issues related to the Strategic Plan
- Interim report published, will be sent to the extraordinary meeting of TDAG scheduled for 23 November 2020
- Additional meetings will be held, on dates TBC, following TDAG 2020/3
- Its final report will first go to the 2021 meeting of TDAG, and will include the progress report on the Buenos Aires Action Plan as well as proposals regarding the ITU-D component of the Strategic and Operational Plans
