Working Group 1 (WG1): Programmes, Study Groups and Associated Questions

- Consider matters relating to ITU-D Programmes, Study Groups and Associated Questions taking into account the strategic goals and objectives of the ITU in particular to those of ITU-D;
- Assess the achievements of the relevant parts of the Buenos Aires Action Plan,



Structure of Working Groups (2)

- Source Working Group 2 (WG2): Working Methods, Declaration and, Action Plan
 - Review the ITU-D's Working Methods, particularly in regard to the organization of and procedures associated with meetings of the Telecommunication Development Advisory Group (TDAG) and Study Groups, in the interests of optimizing and enhancing their effectiveness and efficiency during the forthcoming period;
 - Identify any issues that need stronger support and commitment of the APT Members and to prepare draft inputs for Declaration and Action Plan of the WTDC,
- Working Group 3 (WG3): General ICT Development Issues including Regional Initiatives
 - Identify key issues for the regional ICT development, including general policy and cooperation among memberships, taking into account the needs of the region and the relevant Strategic Plan of the APT;
 - Solution Discuss and develop proposals for Regional Initiatives for Asia-Pacific region;
 - Consider other matters not covered by WG1 and WG2,



Deliverables of APT WTDC21

APT

APT Common Proposal (ACP)

A document containing subject matter developed by the APT WTDC21 and endorsed by the required number of APT Members for submission by the Secretary General as a multi-country proposal to another organization *Note: Member consultation is required*

APT View

A view approved by the plenary of the APT WTDC21 on certain matters, which can be submitted to an international organization by the Secretary General on behalf of Members participating at that plenary *Note: Plenary approval is required*



Conditions for PACPs

- PACPs should be, as far as possible, be adopted by consensus at the Plenary of APT-WTDC;
- However, if there is a difference of opinion at the Plenary and further discussion cannot produce consensus then, as a last resort, document can be adopted provided that:
 - the document is supported by at least one quarter (25%) of the APT Members present at the Plenary; AND,
 - the document is not opposed by a number of Members present at the Plenary greater than the number of Members who support it.



Conditions for ACPs

- PACPs are required to be circulated to all APT Members (38 Members) through the APT Secretariat for endorsement. Once the PACPs meet the criteria below, the PACPs become ACPs,
- On confirmation of a proposal as a PACP, all APT Members will be asked to consider inclusion of heir country name as a signatory to that proposal. A PACP becomes an ACP provided that:
 - the proposal is supported by at least one quarter (25%) of the APT Members; AND
 - the proposal is not opposed by more than 50% of the number of Members who support it.
