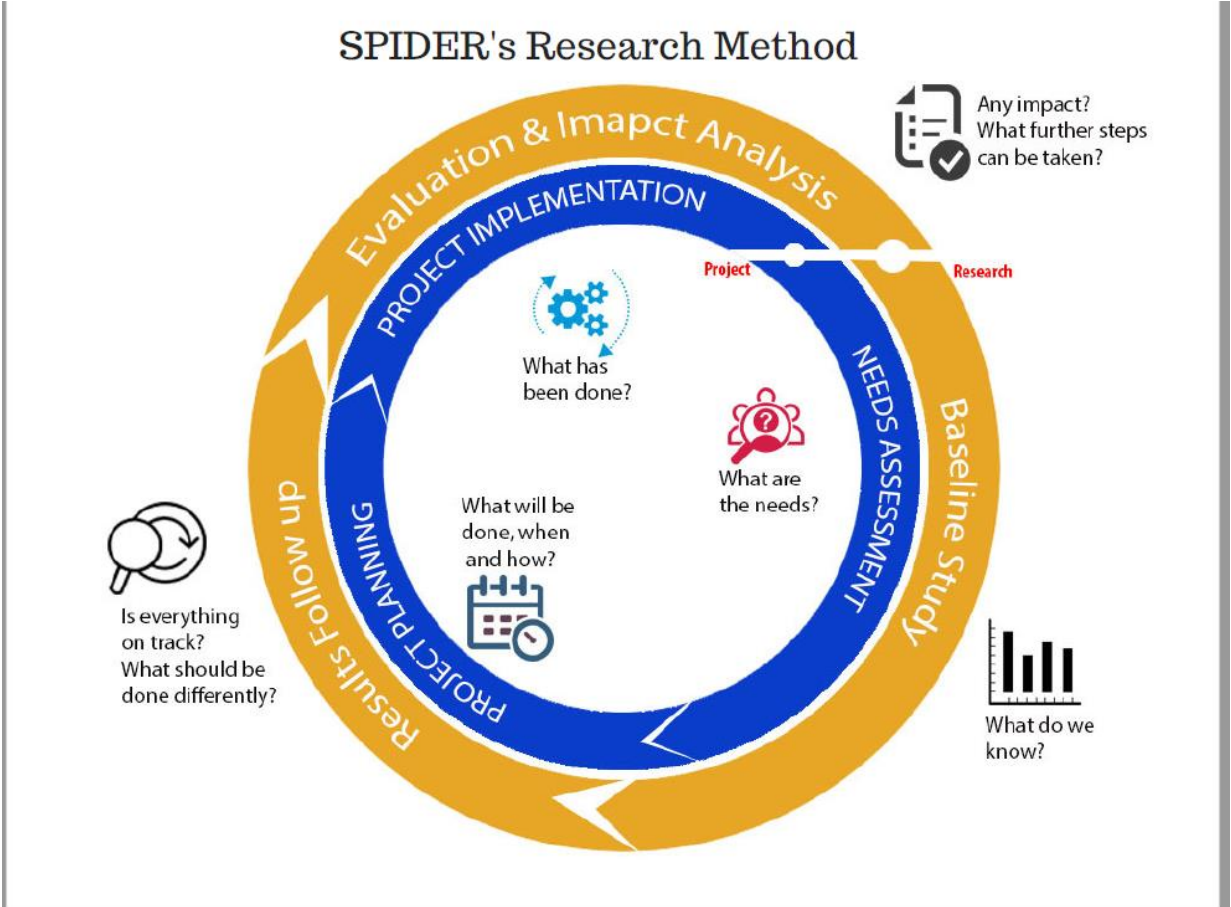

Organisation Based

Researchers are selected through a competitive process and they must be attached to a public or private research institutions within the country where the project is implemented. This is a part of institutional capacity building.

Experience

Researchers should be knowledgeable and have the competence to carry out research on particular issues addressed by the project for example issues concerning health, education, transparency and accountability, etcetra.

Local

Researchers are recruited from local communities and the where the project is implemented. The aim is to find researchers who understand the challenges of the community but also to build local caoacity for sustanability purposes
