- ▶ Update your TIES or Guest account profile.
- ▶ Create your own Guest account.
- ▶ Recover your password. **(For Guest accounts only!)**

WHAT'S NEW?

- ▶ **User-friendly interface**
The new interface shows complete details of the service, allows quick subscription through direct access to a group containing the different services, and provides current status of any subscriptions pending approval.
- ▶ **Enhanced visibility of services**
Every user (TIES and Guest) will be allowed to see the entire ITU service catalog and to subscribe automatically to open services or request subscriptions to restricted or previously hidden services.

Click on the “Login” button and identify yourself with your TIES username and password, or your Guest account username and password.

1. How do I subscribe to a mailing list?

To subscribe, simply tick on the check box next to the service(s) and click on the Subscribe/Request subscription button.

2. How do I unsubscribe to a mailing list?

Select from the Service Catalog tree the group where the mailing list you want to unsubscribe to belongs. The mailing list you are subscribed to will be displayed under the **Active Subscriptions** tab. To unsubscribe, simply tick on the check box next to the service and click on the Unsubscribe button.

3. How do I find out which e-mail mailing lists I have subscribed to?

Depending on the group you select under the Service Catalog tree, only services which you are subscribed to will be displayed under the **Active Subscriptions** tab.
