- SG3 appointed Rapporteurs and Associate Rapporteurs (<u>SG3-TD17/PLEN</u> and <u>SG3-TD43-R1/PLEN</u>) for the 10 SG3 Questions.
- SG3 representatives to various groups were appointed.

Key Results

- SG3 continues to use the Traditional Approval Process (TAP) as the default approval process for normative texts.
- The stale work items will be reviewed at the SG3 meeting in March 2020, and all remaining stale WIs be discontinued.
- SG3 initiated the deletion procedure for Recommendation ITU-T D.280 (03/95), "Principles for charging and billing, accounting and reimbursements for universal personal telecommunication" (TSB Circular 21) (in coordination with SG2 to delete all UPT Recommendations).
- The objectives of upcoming SG3 Rapporteur Group Meetings (Geneva, 7-10 November 2022) were set (SG3-TD35/PLEN).
- SG3-internal coordination session on Distributed Ledger Technologies (DLT) was organized.

OTT matters

- No decision taken on proposed new Question for SG3 on OTTs as received by WTSA-20 (<u>SG3-C2</u>),
 discussions continue.
- Question 9/3 appears as best place to study OTTs.
- A drafting session took place for an ITU-T A.13 template NWI on OTTs;
 The NWI is to find alternative/compromise on the former stale mate work item proposal on OTT taxation.
- A new Correspondence Group on OTTs (CG-OTTs) was initiated, under the leadership of Ms. Cynthia Reddock-Downes (Trinidad and Tobago), with the assistance of Mr. Joaquim Simao Zindoga (Mozambique), Mr. Amit Sharma (Telecom Regulatory Authority of India), and Ms. Pauline T. Djoumessi Gnimpieba (Cameroon).
- The CG-OTTs is to further develop the draft NWI proposal until the SG3 RGMs in November 2022;
 with the possibility to establish that proposed work item at the SG3 plenary in Geneva on 11
 November 2022.
 - CG-OTTs may also discuss proposals for other candidate new work items under Question 9/3, including possible work items having other forms of target deliverables.
- Preparations for a planned ITU Workshop in the area of Digital/OTT Taxation (exact title to be defined) were re-initiated, under the leadership of Mr. Fernando de Faria Siqueira (Brazil).
