## I. Introduction: WSIS Forum 2022

### *ICTs for Well-being, Inclusion and Resilience: WSIS Cooperation for Accelerating Progress on the SDGs*

The World Summit on the Information Society Forum (WSIS) 2022 represents the world's largest annual gathering of the ICT for development community. The WSIS Forum, co-organized by ITU, UNESCO, UNDP and UNCTAD, in close collaboration with all WSIS Action Line Facilitators/Co-Facilitators, has proven to be an efficient mechanism for coordination of multi-stakeholder implementation activities, information exchange, creation of knowledge, sharing of best practices and continues to provide assistance in developing multi-stakeholder and public/private partnerships to advance development goals. This Forum provided structured opportunities to network, learn and participate in multi-stakeholder discussions and consultations on WSIS implementation. The Agenda and Programme of the Forum were built on the basis of the submissions received during the Open Consultation Process.

The WSIS Forum 2022 was organised in a hybrid format by ITU as the lead coordinator, in collaboration with the co-organisers UNESCO, UNCTAD, and UNDP, and in close collaboration with more than 30 UN agencies. It started in a virtual format, from the 15th of March until the 27th of May. The final week of the WSIS Forum 2022, from the 30th of May until the 3rd of June, was held both physically at the ITU Headquarters and in a virtual format. The WSIS Forum 2022 provided an inclusive global multistakeholder platform for all to exchange knowledge and information, enhance collaborative networks, and to share best practices in the information and communication technologies (ICTs) sector. Involving all WSIS stakeholders (governments, civil society, private sector entities, academia and international organizations), this process aims to ensure an active participation of different players during the event. The WSIS Forum is the only event of its kind where the agenda is completely crowdsourced.

The Forum's theme this year, "WSIS Forum 2022 ICTs for Well-Being, Inclusion and Resilience (WSIS Cooperation for Accelerating Progress on the SDGs)" created an opportunity for WSIS stakeholders to share their efforts and innovative ideas to leverage the ICTs. ICTs experts and implementation actors contributed to and participated in the WSIS Forum 2022 to foster partnerships, showcase innovation, exchange best practices and announce new tools and initiatives to use ICTs (WSIS Action Lines) to advance the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Also, it built momentum to advance action-oriented dialogue on efforts in the context of COVID-19 recovery and initiatives to implement the WSIS Action Lines to advance the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals.

Over the course of twelve weeks (since March 2022), the WSIS Forum 2022 hosted more than 250 sessions, including thematic workshops, country workshops, WSIS Action Line Facilitation meetings, high-level dialogues, high-level policy sessions, knowledge

cafes and open-space talks enabled on-site as well as virtual participants from over 150 countries to engage with more than 500 high-level representatives of the wider WSIS Stakeholder community, including ministers and deputies, ambassadors; and leaders from the private sector, academia and civil society. In effect, the WSIS Forum 2022 garnered a lot of interest and excitement worldwide – with a cumulative attendance of more than 30,000 remote participants since 15 March and with the WSIS Forum 2022 final week that welcomed more than 1,000 physical participants.

**2. Matrix: WSIS Forum 2022 Session/Workshops Links to the WSIS Action Lines and to the SDGs**

The [WSIS-SDG Matrix](#) developed by UN WSIS Action Line Facilitators serves as the mechanism to map, analyze and coordinate the implementation of WSIS Action Lines, and more specifically, ICTs as enablers and accelerators of the SDGs. This Matrix builds upon the WSIS-SDG Matrix and provides guidance on the outcomes of the workshops and other sessions held during the forum, emphasizing linkages between the WSIS Action Lines and SDGs as well as highlighting rationale for each linkage that has been established. WSIS Stakeholders identified a clear relation and connection between the WSIS Action Lines and SDGs in their respective workshops.

Among the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), this session is primarily linked to Goal 11: Make cities inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable. That is because the vast majority of emergency situations requiring public alerts occur at the scale of local communities and cities.

Experts studying Climate Change caution that weather-related hazard threats are becoming even more severe and more frequent over the coming decades. That reality makes it all the more important to enhance emergency alerting in societies worldwide, and links this session to Goal 13: Take urgent action to combat climate change and its impacts.

An enhanced emergency alerting infrastructure can help with Goal 14: Conserve and sustainably use the oceans, seas and marine resources and with Goal 15: Sustainably manage forests, combat desertification, halt and reverse land degradation, halt biodiversity loss. A specific example is the use of CAP in the European SAFERS project, which is focused on emergency alerts for forest fires.
