Christoph Legutko began his professional career in 1982 when he joined an electronic utility company in Germany. He developed distance and movement sensors. In the nineties he focused as project manager for market development for computing and telecommunication investment goods. He set up the sales organisations, introduced CAD-software and telecommunication hardware products into international markets as Area Manager for countries in Eastern and Northern Europe.

His move to the Siemens Mobile Network Division took place in 2000. There he is responsible for frequency policy issues for the whole mobile products sector. He is a Siemens Information and Communication delegate to ITU-R, especially Working Party 8F and to Project Team 1 of the European Radio Committee (CEPT/ECC PT1). He is an active member of the UMTS-Forum Spectrum Aspects Group and Issue Manager for IMT-2000 Spectrum Issue of EICTA RSPC.
