

Konstantin Kolomensky was born in 1957. In 1980 he graduated from Leningrad Electrical Engineering University (LEEU) and since then had been working as an engineer at the Radio Engineering Department of LEEU. In 1986 he got his PhD degree in Electrical Engineering from LEEU. From 1986 to 1993 while working as an Assistant Professor he had been also involved in scientific research in the area of air navigation system algorithm development. Since 1993 he has been working at DELTA Telecom – the first cellular operator in Russia. He had different positions within the company and since December 2000 Konstantin Kolomensky has been working as Network Development Director. He was a member of Digital Interest Group formed by NMT MoU to define high level requirements and to choose technology for digitalization of the cellular systems working in 450 MHz band. During the last years he has been actively participating in CDMA450 project and specifically in roll-out and operation of the first Russian CDMA450 network (SkyLink).
