Christoph Legutko is Wireless Standards and Regulations Manager of Intel Corporation in Germany since 2006. He is responsible for Global Public Policy in the telecommunication sector in German speaking and in Central East European countries. He represents Intel at ITU, CEPT/ECC and another regulatory and industrial bodies.

Before joining Intel he was 21 years with Siemens.

For the last 6 years with Siemens he was responsible for frequency policy issues for the whole mobile products sector of Siemens Communications.

In the nineties he focused on markets' development for computing and telecommunication investment goods. He set up the sales organisations to introduce IT software as well as telecommunication hardware systems into the international markets as Area Manager for countries in Eastern and Northern Europe.

In his first years for Siemens he has developed I/O processor for main frame computers and a RISC CPU.

He began his professional career in 1982 when he joined a medium-sized electronic company in Germany where he developed distance and movement sensors.
