

Marco Carugi, Senior Expert, ZTE Corporation, R&D and Standards

- Marco began his career as telecommunication system engineer in Solvay, then worked for 8 years in France Telecom R&D as Research Engineer in Broadband Data Services and Network Technologies (expert in IP/MPLS and VPNs).
- He joined Nortel in 2002 as Senior Advisor in the CTO organization, focusing on NGN and emerging services.
- Since August 2010 he works for ZTE in the R&D Product organization, focusing on future service and network technologies, and associated standardization.
- Marco actively participates since 1996 in standardization, including ITU-T SG13, ETSI TISPAN, IETF and OIF. He has held numerous management positions in SDOs, including in ITU-T NGN FG, ITU-T SG13 (Rapporteur - 8 years), OIF Board of Directors, IETF Provider Provisioned VPN (working group chair). He is currently vice-Chairman of SG13, and acts also as Rapporteur for Q.3/13 (Requirements and implementation scenarios for emerging services and capabilities in an evolving NGN) and co-chair of Working Party 2/13. He is involved in SDP work in ITU-T SG13 (as Rapporteur) and in cloud work in ITU-T FG Cloud Computing (as co-Editor) and IETF.
- Marco has authored a number of papers, IETF drafts and RFCs, ITU-T Recommendations, and been speaker/organiser of numerous international conferences.
- He holds Electronic Engineering degree in Telecommunications from Pisa University (Italy), M.S. in Engineering and Management of Telecommunication Networks from INT (Evry, France), Master in International Business Development from ESSEC Business School (Paris).
