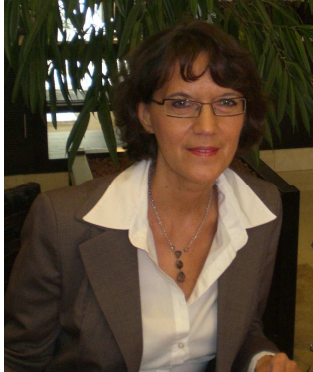


Biography:



Mrs Halina Uryga is Deputy Director of Spectrum in France Telecom - Orange Group. She is responsible for frequency linked issues for UMTS/IMT-2000 and IMT-Advanced. The scope of her work encompasses development of strategy for extension of UMTS coverage and policy related to estimation of market and related new spectrum needs for IMT-Advanced, in consultation with other operators and manufacturers. Mrs Uryga has been an active member of the French delegations to WRC-97, 2000, 2003 and 2007. She is actively involved in the work of a number of international fora working on UMTS/IMT-2000 and IMT-Advanced, such as ITU, CEPT, UMTS Forum, ETSI. She participates also as associate member in the work of CITELEC PCC II.
