Dear Sir/Madam,

1 In accordance with the decisions of Study Group 2 taken at its plenary session on 14 September 2001, I would like to inform you that a Tutorial Workshop on ENUM will take place at ITU headquarters, Geneva, on 8 February 2002.

2 The workshop will open at 0900 hours. Detailed information concerning the meeting rooms will be displayed on screens at the entrances to ITU headquarters. Registration will take place from 0830 hours in the second basement level of the ITU Tower Building.

3 An interpretation service will be provided for the meeting in accordance with the provisions in force.

8 We would remind you that citizens of some countries are required to obtain a visa in order to enter and spend any time in Switzerland. The visa must be requested and obtained from the office (embassy or consulate) representing Switzerland in your country or, if there is no such office in your country, from the one that is closest to the country of departure. If problems are encountered, the Union can, at the official request of the administration or company you represent, approach the competent Swiss authorities in order to facilitate delivery of the visa. Any such request must specify the name and functions of the individual(s) for whom the visa(s) is/are requested and be accompanied by a copy of the registration form approved by the ITU conference or meeting in question.

The purpose of this tutorial workshop is to provide information to facilitate discussion so the requirements for the successful global implementation of ENUM. The ENUM protocol is a mapping into the Internet Domain Name System (DNS) of parts or all of the international public telecommunication numbering plan defined in ITU-T Recommendation E.164. At first glance a simple protocol, ENUM raises a number of regulatory and policy issues, some of which will be explored in the workshop. The workshop may generate more questions than answers but hopefully it will become one of many contributions to an informed debate by the ITU membership.
