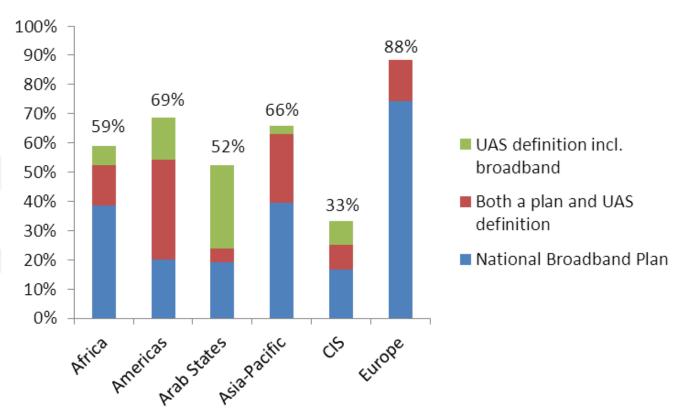

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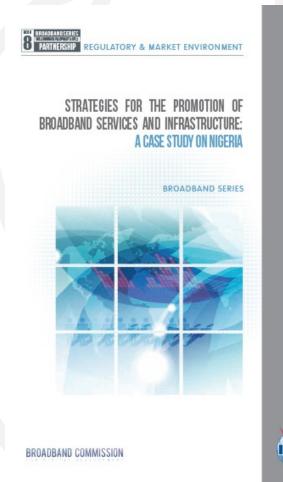
Strategies for promotion of broadband services and infrastructure





- Responsible Ministry and the ICT regulator each developed strategies to boost the Information society
- Efforts made by the Regulator to ensure clarity and predictability in the regulatory regime
- Competition between ISPs and the presence of cable operators offered alternatives to the incumbent fixed network

2000-2010	0.32% of GDP 6.9% of all GDP growth	0.44% of GDP 9.6% of all GDP growth
2005-2010	0.61% of GDP 7.3 % of all economic growth	0.82% of GDP 11.3 % of all economic growth
