Since 1984, he has been involved in the international standardization of video coding and audiovisual communication systems. He led Specialists Group on Coding for Visual Telephony of CCITT SGXV during 1984 - 1990 which developed Recommendation H.261, and Experts Group for Video Coding and Systems in ATM and Other Network Environments during 1990 - 1996 as well as Requirements Sub-group of ISO/IEC JTC1/SC29/WG11 (MPEG) during 1991 - 1995 which collaboratively developed the common text ITU-T Rec. H.262|ISO/IEC 13818-2 (known as MPEG-2 video). He has been CCITT/ITU-T Rapporteur for the related Questions since 1985 and responsible for audiovisual communication system Recommendations such as H.320 (N-ISDN), H.310/321 (B-ISDN), H.322/H.323 (LANs). He now serves as Chairman of Working Party 2 (Multimedia systems and terminals) in ITU-T SG16.
