## Subject: Innovate2Connect: Mainstreaming entrepreneurship-driven innovation to accelerate digital transformation, 21 July 2021, 14:00 to 15:30 CEST

I have the pleasure to invite you to participate in the sixth virtual event of The Road to Addis series organized by the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) to be held on 21 July 2021, from 14:00 to 15:30 CEST.
