Information note for participants of the 3rd meeting of TDAG-WG-SOP

Registration, access and participation

A User account with TIES access allows delegates to access ITU information resources including contributions and other working documents.

Note: For delegates who already created their user account when registering to previous events on this same system can still use the same account.

All registration requests for participation in TDAG-WG-SOP must be **validated by the Designated Focal Points (DFPs)** of administrations and entities entitled to participate. To modify the contact details of a Designated Focal Point or to change the Designated Focal Point, an official letter from an authorized official should be sent to the BDT Meetings Registration Service (by e-mail to: bdtmeetingsregistration@itu.int), providing the new DFP's last name, first name and e-mail address.
