I am pleased to invite you to participate in the Regional Development Forum for the Commonwealth of Independent States (RDF-CIS), which is organized by the Telecommunication Development Bureau (BDT) of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) and will be held in Bishkek, Kyrgyz Republic, from 1 to 2 October 2019 at the kind invitation of the State Committee of Information Technologies and Communications of the Kyrgyz Republic.

Regional development forums provide an opportunity for high-level dialogue between BDT and decision-makers of ITU Member States and Sector Members as well as other stakeholders. They serve as a platform for assessing strategic orientations that may have an impact on BDT's regional work plan in between world telecommunication development conferences (WTDCs).

In this context, RDF-CIS will report on the implementation of the Buenos Aires Action Plan. Particular emphasis will be placed on the regional initiatives approved by WTDC-17, providing all stakeholders with an opportunity to discuss implementation plans, announce commitments and exchange experiences and best practices. The RDF-CIS will also address, from a regional perspective, the activities related to the Telecommunication Development Advisory Group (TDAG), ITU-D Study Groups, Membership, Partnerships and ITU Centres of Excellence. The draft agenda of the Forum is attached as Annex 1.

RDFs are open to all stakeholders willing to strengthen cooperation and partnerships among telecommunication/ICT policy-makers, regulators, industry, academia, regional and international development agencies and organizations on specific regional telecommunication and ICT matters.

The Forum will be conducted in Russian and English with simultaneous interpretation.

Dubai, 2018) and 213 (Dubai, 2018) of the ITU Plenipotentiary Conference, and in order to promote the participation of developing countries in ITU activities, ITU will grant one full or two partial fellowships per eligible country of the CIS region, subject to the availability of funds. An application for a fellowship must be authorized by the relevant Administration. 
