In the ITU Basic Texts

- The Constitution (Article 21) defines the Functions and Structure of the ITU-D and establishes that the work of the Sector shall work through:
 - World telecommunication development conferences,
 - Telecommunication development study groups;
 - The Telecommunication Development Advisory Group (TDAG), and
 - The Telecommunication Development Bureau (BDT) headed by the elected Director.
- The roles of each of the above bodies are further defined in the ITU Convention (Section 7, Article 16)

What does TDAG do?

- Based on WTDC Resolution 24 (Rev. Dubai, 2014), WTDC tasks <u>TDAG</u> with a number of tasks to be carried out between WTDCs;
- Normally, TDAG meets annually;
- Its main role is to advise the Director of BDT on the work of BDT, examining the report of the implementation of the previous action plan and providing guidance to address any shortcomings, and advising on how to pursue this implementation;
- TDAG is led by the TDAG Bureau;
- Membership <u>submit contributions</u> to TDAG;
- TDAG is <u>contribution-driven</u>.

WTDC

• The outputs of WTDC are listed in WTDC Resolution 1:

1.8.1 WTDC shall consider reports from the Director of the Telecommunication Development Bureau (BDT) and, pursuant to No. 208 of the Convention, shall establish work programmes and guidelines for defining telecommunication development questions and priorities and shall provide direction and guidance for the ITU-D work programme. It shall decide on the need to maintain, terminate or establish study groups, allocate to each of them the Questions to be studied and, taking into account consideration by the heads of delegation, appoint the chairmen and vice-chairmen of study groups, of TDAG and of any other groups it has established, taking account of Article 20 of the Convention. The study group chairmen themselves shall, during the conference, be at the disposal of WTDC to provide information on matters relating to the study group they chair.

1.8.2 WTDC shall establish a declaration, a plan of action, including programmes and regional initiatives, ITU-D's contribution to the draft ITU strategic plan, ITU-D study group Questions, as well as resolutions and Recommendations.

World Telecommunication Development Conference


- □ Statutory, non-treaty signing conference
- □ Held every four years
- Attended by <u>membership</u>: ITU Member States and Academia, and by <u>ITU-D</u> <u>Sector Members</u>
- □ It is a contribution-driven conference
- Membership deliberate about the contributions submitted and produce a Final Report comprising:
 - Declaration
 - o Action Plan
 - Resolutions
 - Strategic Plan

WTDC

 The <u>Final Report</u> is produced on the last day of WTDC, usually in the six ITU official languages (Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Russian and Spanish)







Submission of contributions to WTDC


- In order to facilitate preparation and submission of the proposals and speed up their processing, avoiding errors, membership are encouraged to use the <u>Conference Proposals Interface (CPI)</u>;
- Submitted proposals will also be available for perusal on the Proposals Management System (WTDC-17 version);
- Full documents will be available on the WTDC website (WTDC-17 documents page);

SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS

To facilitate the preparatory process and the revision of existing texts, such as Resolutions, and study group Questions, an interim Conference Proposal Interface (CPI) has been set up. This system allows membership to submit revisions and new text, and to view and amend other Members' proposals and is intended to be an important tool towards consensus building prior to WTDC.

Proposals will be submitted to a generic Inter-Regional Meeting and will be made available to all membership to browse and

peruse.

A CPI for IRMs has been made available for membership to be able to access existing texts to be discussed and revised during their preparatory process.

They may also wish to submit proposals to IRMs.



Registering for events

- <u>Online registration</u> is mandatory for all the events mentioned, whether virtual or physical;
- Given that they are statutory events, DFP approval is required (DFP = Designated Focal Point);
- Once the registration is approved, the participant receives a confirmation email (make sure you keep it) which:
 - Allows for badge pick-up (physical events);
 - Provides information to access the virtual meeting room (virtual events).
