

 ICTs to support e.g. smart villages, telepsychiatry, disaster response and recovery, environment, new EMF scenarios



# 2018-2022 joint survey findings

- 68 responses (37 responses in previous survey)
- Highest % of respondents from developing countries
- Attendance to virtual meetings were high as they are less resource intensive.

- Lack of budget is the main reason for not attending physical meetings in the past
- Member States are perceived as encouraging SMEs, academia and industry participation in study groups' work
- Perceived that certain important topics were not being addressed by study questions
