ETC Overview

Purpose: Designed to assist emergency telecommunication stakeholders in the planning, design, conducting and follow up of a table-top simulation.

Value: Participants build their understanding of systems, procedures and structures in place to support emergency responses. They also are able to identify gaps and issues that need to be addressed through preparedness measures.



ETC Structure

Phase 1: Plan

Phase 2: Design

Phase 3: Conduct

Phase 4: Follow-up

Application: This guidance focuses on table-top simulations (TTX) which are a desk-based exercise. Participants are presented with a disaster scenario and expected to respond to questions, resolve presented “problems”, and undertake actions.
