Kaloyan Kamenov is a health professional with over 10 years' experience in public health, epidemiology, health research and programme development.

He has a PhD in psychology from the Autonomous University of Madrid, and research master's in clinical and developmental psychopathology from Vrije Universitat Amsterdam, The Netherlands.

Kaloyan is currently a Technical Officer (Disability) at the World Health Organization Headquarters in Geneva, where he is responsible for the development of normative documents and supporting Member States in capacity building on disability inclusion in the health sector. He coordinated the development of the WHO Global report on health equity for persons with disabilities.

Prior to this, Kaloyan was supporting the Sensory Functions, disability and rehabilitation unit at WHO in the implementation of the Make Listening Safe initiative to prevent hearing loss due to unsafe recreational listening practices. Before joining WHO, Kaloyan was working as a mental health researcher at the Autonomous University of Madrid, Spain.
