



## **Masahito Kawamori**

Dr. Masahito Kawamori, Project Professor, Keio University (Japan)

Since 2009, he is the Rapporteur of Question 28 "Multimedia Framework for Digital Health Applications" in Study Group 16 of ITU-T. He is working with WHO on many initiatives, including "Making Listening Safe" and "Accessibility to Telehealth". Since 1998 until 2002, he was a research member of "Creating the Brain" Research Project of the JST (Japan Science and Technology Agency)'s CREST ("Core Research for Evolutional Science and Technology") Program. He was also a lecturer, 1998-2006, at the School of Allied Health Sciences, Kitasato University, Japan. In 2004, he led the development with the University of Tokyo, Japan, on a health information system using wearable sensors that measured the hippocampal function in the brain to detect early signs of dementia. In addition to safe-listening and accessible telehealth, he is currently working on Health Data Exchange for long-term healthcare institutions in various countries.
