Dr. Masahito Kawamori, Project Professor, Keio University (Japan)

Since 2009, he is the Rapporteur of Question 28 "Multimedia Framework for Digital Health Applications" in Study Group 16 of ITU-T. He is working with WHO on many initiatives, including "Making Listening Safe" and "Accessibility to Telehealth". Since 1998 until 2002, he was a research member of "Creating the Brain" Research Project of the JST (Japan Science and Technology Agency)'s CREST ("Core Research for Evolutional Science and Technology") Program. He was also a lecturer, 1998-2006, at the School of Allied Health Sciences, Kitasato University, Japan. In 2004, he led the development with the University of Tokyo, Japan, on a health information system using wearable sensors that measured the hippocampal function in the brain to detect early signs of dementia. In addition to safelistening and accessible telehealth, he is currently working on Health Data Exchange for long-term healthcare institutions in various countries.
