Dr Hang Su is an Associate Professor in the Department of Computer Science at Tsinghua University. His research is primarily focused on machine learning, embodied learning, and AI safety, areas in which he has published over 100 papers in prestigious venues such as CVPR, ECCV, and TMI. Dr Su boasts a Google Scholar citation count exceeding 11,000, reflecting the significant impact of his work. He has played pivotal roles in the academic community, including serving as an area chair for NeurIPS and as workshop co-chair for AAI 2022. His contributions have been recognized with several awards: the Young Investigator Award from MICCAI in 2012, the Best Paper Award at AVSS 2012, and the Platinum Best Paper Award at ICME 2018. Additionally, Dr Su is the chair of the working group for IEEE 7018, which focuses on the safety and trustworthiness of pretrained generative models, underscoring his commitment to advancing responsible AI practices.
