Subject: Radiocommunication Study Group 5 (Terrestrial Services)

Proposed approval of 1 draft revised ITU-R Recommendation

At the meeting of Radiocommunication Study Group 5 held on 16 December 2021, the Study Group decided to seek adoption of 1 draft revised ITU-R Recommendation by correspondence, in accordance with § A2.6.2.2.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-8. The Recommendation has now been adopted by Study Group 5 and the approval procedure of Resolution ITU-R 1-8, § A2.6.2.3 is to be applied. The title and the summary of the draft Recommendation is given in the Annex to this letter. Any Member State which objects to the approval of a draft Recommendation is requested to inform the Director and the Chairman of the Study Group of the reasons for the objection.

As stated in Administrative Circular CACE/1012, dated 22 December 2021, the consultation period for the adoption of the Recommendation ended on 22 February 2022.

Having regard to the provisions of § A2.6.2.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-8, Member States are requested to inform the Secretariat (brsgd@itu.int) by 3 May 2022, whether they approve or do not approve the proposal above.

After the above-mentioned deadline, the results of this consultation will be announced in an Administrative Circular and the approved Recommendation will be published as soon as practicable (see http://www.itu.int/pub/R-REC).

Any ITU member organization aware of a patent held by itself or others which may fully or partly cover elements of the draft Recommendation mentioned in this letter is requested to disclose such information to the Secretariat as soon as possible.
