The Administration of Luxembourg has considered serious concerns regarding the very late contribution to the RRB, sent on the 13<sup>th</sup> of July by the Russian Federation, requesting an extension of the regulatory time-limit to bring into use the frequency assignments to the ENSAT-23E satellite network.
