Dear Madam/Sir.

By letter DM-1031 of 30 May 2003, Member States of Region 1 and the Islamic Republic of Iran were invited to indicate their position on the modifications to the agenda of the Regional Radiocommunication Conference for planning of the digital terrestrial broadcasting service in parts of Regions 1 and 3 in the frequency bands 174 - 230 MHz and 470 - 862 MHz, contained in Resolution 1185 as modified by Council 2003.

The number of replies to this consultation, which was due by 18 July 2003, did not exceed one-half of the Member States consulted and entitled to vote. Consequently, a further consultation shall take place, the results of which shall be decisive regardless of the number of votes cast.

Therefore, all Member States of the planning area are once again invited to indicate their position as to the proposed modifications to the agenda of the Regional Radiocommunication Conference for planning of the digital terrestrial broadcasting service in parts of Regions 1 and 3 in the frequency bands 174 - 230 MHz and 470 - 862 MHz, contained in Resolution 1185, as modified by Council 2003, preferably by fax (+41 22 730 6675), by **10 October 2003** at 23h59 UTC, at the latest.
