#### Registration

Registration for the 2018 ordinary session of the Council started on 15 January 2018 and is carried out exclusively online at the Council website (<a href="https://www.itu.int/en/council/Pages/Registration.aspx">https://www.itu.int/en/council/Pages/Registration.aspx</a>).
