Further to circular letters [Nos. 20/51](#) and [21/3](#), and in view of the COVID-19 pandemic resulting on restrictions on work and travel, I am pleased to inform you that the next WTSA has been rescheduled from 1 to 9 March 2022 after the Global Standards Symposium on 28 February 2022, both in Hyderabad, India, subject to the restoration of work and travel conditions in India and in other Member States.

In accordance with Article 25 of the Convention of the International Telecommunication Union and Section 3 of the General Rules of Conferences, Assemblies and Meetings of the Union, I therefore have great pleasure in hereby inviting your Government to send a delegation to WTSA-20 and to the Global Standards Symposium (GSS-20).
