As a result, Member States of ITU have agreed to reschedule the next WTDC from 6 to 15 June 2022.

Result of consultation

Change of dates of WTDC-21

By [Circular Letter No. 21/19](#) of 14 May 2021, the Secretary-General invited the Member States of ITU to confirm in writing their agreement with the change of dates of WTDC-21.

The result of the consultation is as follows:
