The event will take place from 13:00 to 14:30 (CEST) at ITU Headquarters in Popov room, with remote participation.

This year's theme, "**Digital technologies for Older Persons and Healthy Ageing**" will represent a unique opportunity for the ITU membership, partners, and other stakeholders to raise awareness of the important role of telecommunications/ICTs in supporting people to stay healthy, connected, and independent physically, emotionally, and financially - for a longer life and healthy ageing.

The ceremony will include a <u>high-level panel session</u> to reflect on how digital technologies and ICT-driven innovations are helping people build smarter cities, combat age-based discrimination at the workplace, ensure financial inclusion of older persons, and support millions of caregivers across the world.
