#### **Practical information**

#### Registration

In line with ITU gender equality and mainstreaming policy and Resolution 198 (Rev. Bucharest, 2022) of the Plenipotentiary Conference on empowerment of youth through telecommunication/information and communication technology, the aim is to organize an inclusive and gender-responsive Council. With that objective in mind, I would like to invite you to support and encourage the participation of women and young people in your delegation. Contributions to the Council should be submitted as soon as possible to <u>contributions@itu.int</u>. In accordance with Council Decision 556, all contributions should be submitted <u>no later than 14 calendar days</u> before the opening of the meeting, i.e. **5 October 2023.** ITU secretariat documents calling for a decision of the Council will be posted on the relevant page of the website no later than 30 calendar days before the opening of the Additional Council session. Member States will be invited to send their contributions to the meeting by using the <u>template</u> available on the Council-23 website.

As per the <u>ITU information/document access policy</u>, Council input documents will be publicly accessible, unless otherwise requested by the submitter(s) of the document.
