It is my pleasure to invite you to the AI for Good Global Summit to take place from 30 to 31 May 2024 at the International Conference Centre Geneva (CICG) in Geneva, Switzerland. The Summit is the leading United Nations (UN) platform for global and inclusive dialogue on Artificial Intelligence (AI), organized by ITU in partnership with 40 UN agencies and co-convened by the Government of Switzerland.

The AI for Good initiative identifies practical applications of AI to accelerate progress towards the UN Sustainable Development Goals. It connects AI innovators with decision-makers in the public and private sectors to help scale up AI solutions globally.

The 2024 Summit will welcome humanitarian leaders and AI experts from academia and industry to demonstrate how AI can contribute to global progress in areas such as food security, climate action, road safety and healthcare. It will feature talks from thought leaders and demonstrations of state-of-the-art AI solutions that could achieve global scale, and meaningful impact on global challenges, with the support of the international AI for Good community.

A day of discussions dedicated to AI governance on 29 May will gather everyone invested in initiatives underway to address the need for guardrails and global AI governance frameworks. The discussions will benefit from the diversity of participants in the upcoming Summit and the 2024 Forum of the World Summit on the Information Society, this year held in conjunction to capitalize on the two events' complementary perspectives on digital development.

The Summit will be preceded by Machine Learning Workshops from 27 to 29 May.
