Subject: Consultation on further improvements of the ITU Plenipotentiary Conference

Dear Sir/Madam,

At its 2023 session, the Council noted the report of the secretariat ($\underline{C23/4}$) as well as the contribution from Romania, the PP-22 Host Country ($\underline{C23/84}$), suggesting improvements to the work of the Plenipotentiary Conference (PP).

The Council (<u>C23/107</u>, para 1.9):

requested the secretariat to examine the proposals made by Romania to improve the conference roll-out, to consult the Member States on possible improvements to PP, including review of the election procedures and ethical guidelines, and to present the findings to Council-24.

With a view to prepare this report for the Council, I would therefore like to invite Member States to **submit contributions and views** on measures that would make PP more efficient and modern.

Replies can also be sent in Word format to <u>gbs@itu.int</u>.

When preparing responses, Member States are encouraged to share ideas and best practices they could be aware of in other fora and events, including other ITU and UN conferences. They are also invited to consult previous documents on PP modernization (C16/4, CL-16/48, C17/4(Rev.1), C17/INF/6, C17/DL/8, CL-19/57, C20/INF/8, C21/4(Rev.1), C21/13).

Responses should be submitted by 27 March 2024.

It will be my pleasure to consolidate submitted views to have them reviewed at the 2024 Council Session to be held from 4 to 14 June 2024.
