2. Existing seven-digit numbers that are consistent with the new plan will not be affected by this number change. For example numbers of the form 35XXXXX and 36XXXXX in the Gaborone Area will not be affected. However, existing seven-digit numbers that are not consistent with the new numbering plan, for example 36XXXXX outside the Gaborone Area (e.g. in Francistown), will be changed in due course. Users of seven-digit numbers that are not consistent with the new plan will be given sufficient notice before their numbers are changed.

3. The five months notice period before the first number change on the 1st July 2001 is intended to allow the business community in the affected villages/towns to configure their telecommunications systems and stationery in accordance with the new numbering system before it is implemented. In addition, both the old six-digit numbers and the new seven-digit numbers will work at the same time for a further period of four months ("the Parallel Running Period"). However, the public is advised to use the new numbers only as soon as they become active. Parallel Running is only intended to assist those who may not be aware of the new numbers (e.g. international callers who may not be aware of the new numbers).

4. The 2001 telephone directory will have both the old six-digit and the new seven-digit numbers (in brackets) for each customer for the whole country. *Botswana Telecommunication Corporation (BTC)* will make further announcements regarding the number change programme. Members of the public should advise their correspondents about the new numbers and the effective date of those numbers as soon as the effective dates are announced.

5. Mobile telephone numbers will not be affected by the number change programme.
