## Approval of ITU-T Recommendations

A. By TSB Circular 121 of 14 August 2002, it was announced that the following revised ITU-T Recommendations were approved, in accordance with the procedures outlined in Resolution 1, Section 9, of the WTSA (Montreal, 2000):

- ITU-T Recommendation D.000 (14/06/2002): Terms and definitions for the D-series Recommendations
- ITU-T Recommendation D.140 (14/06/2002): Accounting rate principles for the international telephone service
- ITU-T Recommendation D.180 (14/06/2002): Occasional provision of circuits for international sound- and television-programme transmissions
- ITU-T Recommendation D.190 (14/06/2002): Exchange of international traffic accounting data between Administrations using electronic data interchange (EDI) techniques

The conditions governing the approval of ITU-T Recommendations were met and 52 Member States participating in the last meeting of Study Group 3 approved the text of these Recommendations during the Plenary session held on 14 June 2002.

The *Department of Communications*, Nuku'alofa, announces that a licence has been granted to a second telecommunication carrier with registered name "Shoreline Communications Ltd." and with tradename known as "Tonfon".

*Tonfon* has commenced operation on 31 July 2002 starting with their international GSM 900 mobile system. Other multimedia services will be commencing at a later date. On the other hand the existing telecommunication carrier "Tonga Communications Corporation Ltd. (TCC)" operates both domestic and international telecommunication services, and the GSM 900 digital mobile system was introduced in December 2001.

It has been decided that the Kingdom of Tonga will migrate to a seven-digit dialling plan. For the time being TCC will continue to operate on its existing five-digit dialling plan, until August 2003. *Tonfon*, on the other hand, is already using the new seven-digit dialling plan, as follows:

Switzerland

Joint Communiqué of 24.IX.2002:

### *Finnish Telex Service*

*Sonera*, Helsinki (Finland) and *Swisscom*, Berne (Switzerland) announce in this joint communiqué that, as from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2002, *Sonera* will no longer be handling telex traffic to and from Finland, such traffic being handled instead by *Swisscom*. The Telex Switching Centre in Helsinki will be closed and all direct circuits to and from Helsinki will cease operation. All traffic destined for the Helsinki centre will have to be routed via the Telex Switching Centre of *Swisscom* in Lugano (Switzerland).

Finnish subscribers' national telex numbers, together with the telex destination code (TDC) "57" allocated to Finland under ITU-T Recommendation F. 69 and the telex network identification code (TNIC) "FI" allocated to Finland under ITU-T Recommendation F. 68, will remain unchanged.

As from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2002, the responsibility for international rates and settlements will reside with *Swisscom*, which will handle direct all negotiations related to telex accounting rates. Telex traffic sent to or by Finnish subscribers shall be considered as Swiss traffic. The total accounting rates and rates division as applied in relations with *Swisscom* shall be applied also for telex traffic originating or terminating in Finland. All administrations/ROA's are kindly requested to update their records accordingly.

As from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2002, *Swisscom* will handle the settlement of telex accounts, which will have to be done separately for telex traffic from/to Switzerland (telex destination code 45) and telex traffic from/to Finland (telex destination code 57). Telex accounts relating to the traffic sent to Finland until and including October 2002 shall be sent to *Sonera* by the end of December 2002. After that term, all telex accounts should be sent to *Swisscom*.
