Migration from seven (7) to eight (8) digits in the National Numbering Plan (NNP)

It is suggested that the present National Numbering Plan (NNP) be amended to include an additional digit in the national number, increasing it to eight (8) digits. To accomplish that, the digit "2" will be added in front of the current national number for ICE's fixed telephony services and the digit "3" will be added in front of the current national number for ICE's mobile telephony services.
