Gibraltar (country code +350)

Communication of 30.XI.2007:

Gibraltar Regulatory Authority (GRA), Gibraltar, announces the introduction on 1 December 2007 of a new numbering plan for Gibraltar.

The main change in the new plan will be the introduction of fixed numbers of eight (8) digits long, the same length as mobile numbers. All current five (5) digit fixed numbers will be changed to eight (8) digit length by adding the digits "200" in front of the number. The changeover will be completed to coincide with the publication of the 2008-2009 Telephone Directory in September 2008.

During the period when both the old and the new subscriber numbers may be dialled, known as parallel-running, existing fixed five (5) digit numbers may be dialled with or without adding the digits "200" in front (e.g. 711 70 or 200 711 70). After the changeover period, all existing fixed subscriber numbers can be dialled only with the eight (8) digit format.

PART 1 – STRUCTURE OF THE PLAN

1 The National (Significant) Number (N(S)N) is currently eight (8) digits long, notated by the sequence "PABCDEF G". The lengths of all number ranges below are clearly marked on the Gibraltar numbering plan in Part 2.

2 The structure of the plan is as follows (with the initial Plan "P" digit identifying the range):

 - 1 Type "C" Access Codes
 - 2 Geographic Numbering Range
