The National (Significant) Number (N(S)N) shall be nine (9) digits, notated by the alphabetical sequence "NN ABC XXXX"; for example, 12 345 6789 represents a geographic number in the Pretoria area. The ABC code "345" represents an exchange area code within the Pretoria area. Existing local (seven (7) digit) numbers are notated by "ABC XXXX", where A = 2 to 9.

Structure of the numbering plan with the national dialling prefix "0" and initial (N) digit identifying the range:

"09" for the international prefix, used to escape from national to international dialling;

"01" to "05" for the geographic area code ranges, digits 1-5 indicating the five primary numbering areas in the Republic;

"07" designated for mobile cellular services and future non-geographic services;

"08" designated for mobile cellular, paging, inbound call services and future non-geographic services;

The "06" range shall be kept in reserve for potential future use; and

Level 1 short codes are also included in the structure of the numbering plan.
