What is TSAG?

- TSAG is an advisory group to the ITU-T Sector, open to all ITU-T membership
- Basic Responsibilities include:
 - Review priorities, programmes, operations, finances, strategies
 - Provide guidelines for work of the SGs
 - ► Foster cooperation within and external to ITU-T
 - Advice on improvements to work methods
 - Recommend creation of other groups, AND...




What is TSAG?

- TSAG earned the trust of the membership through prudent, proactive advice
- WTSA-1996 realized 4 years between Assemblies did not match the rapid pace of telecom developments
- Resolution 22 gave authorization for TSAG to take action between WTSAs on:
 - Changing priorities, work allocation, SG structure, work methods, external relationships, internal coordination,
- TSAG is action-oriented, fast-moving, operates like a Study Group

Hot Issues Cooled by TSAG

- New approval process for Recommendations that do not have policy or regulatory implications
 - ► Reduced ITU-T "time-to-market" of approved, published Recommendations from more than 4 YEARS to about 9 WEEKS, reduced travel and saved TSB several million CHF
- Regularly resolved cross-SG issues and ensured transparency, especially for those who could not attend all meetings
- Moved work between SGs; created coordination groups; achieved "Time-E" for all-electronic capabilities

- Hot Issues Cooled by TSAG
 Provided permanently archived, electronic access to all documents, summaries and explanations of Recommendations to assist developing countries
- Opened new forms of participation and decision-making to close the Standardization Gap
- Improved awareness and reporting for **Workshops and Seminars**
- Turned competition with other standards bodies into cooperation and collaboration
- Free downloading of ITU-T Recommendations

How TSAG Helps ITU-T and You

- By meeting in the same cycle as meetings of the Study Groups, it shortens the time to solve problems and to respond to demands of the membership (i.e., every 8-9 months)
- TSAG Group on Bridging the Standardization Gap
- TSAG Young Delegates Group
- TSAG builds the roads and the bridges that allow all members to navigate through the standards landscape as quickly or as deliberately as they want, ensuring openness and transparency



The Current Hot Issues

- Hot technical issues it is hard to anticipate what the hot technical issues will be in 3, 5 and 10 years
 - The marketplace will let us know
 - TSAG and TSB Technology Watch functions will help
- The Hot TSAG issue is how to ensure ITU-T will be ready, <u>regardless</u> of the technical subject



The Current Hot Issues

- Study Group structure
 - Efficient for those who create the standards
 - Understandable to the outside world that has to communicate with ITU-T
 - Consolidation that groups related work
 - Ensure manageable-sized groupings
 - ► The "RIGHT" groups, not the "right # of groups

The Current Hot Issues

- Coordination
 - Internal, among multiple SGs working on specialized aspects of large projects
 - External, with national and regional bodies, and with forums and consortia
- Continue increased use of ICTs in ITU-T
- Bridging the Standardization Gap
- Technology Watch what are the new areas for standardization within the ITU-T mandate
