What are ITU-D up mailing lists for?

ITU-D mailing lists – what for?



- Allow to easily communicate with the other persons subscribed for one particular topic (for instance, each of the TDAG Correspondence Groups has a list of its own)
- Allow to keep a list of the persons interested in that particular topic
- Allow to consult and peruse archives of exchanged messages

FUNCTIONING OF THE MAILING LIST


- You will need to subscribe and manage your subscription to the list by using your TIES account.
