The goal of this side event is to discuss ways to address the Information and Communication Technology (ICT) development and connectivity challenges for the Landlocked Developing Countries (LLDCs). Addressing ICT connectivity including broadband will help LLDCs address special development challenges such as increased costs due to lack of access to the seaport, long distances to the ports, inadequate telecommunication and ICT infrastructure, inadequate transport infrastructure, and cumbersome customs and border crossing procedure.

The event will identify ICT connectivity priorities and concrete actions to ensure concrete projects are created and implemented through genuine and durable partnerships between governments, private sector and academia.

#### DATES AND VENUE OF THE CONFERENCE and ITU SIDE EVENT:

- 1. The Second United Nations Conference on Landlocked Developing Countries (LLDCs) will be held from 3 to 5 November 2014 in Vienna, Austria, at the Vienna International Centre, located at Wagramer Strasse 5, 1400 Vienna, Austria.
- 2. The ITU Side Event will be held on 3 November 2014 from 08:30hr to 09:50hr, venue will be confirmed at a later date.
- 3. The side event ITU is co-organizing with UN-ORHHLS will be held on 4 November 2014 from 10:00hrs to 16:45hrs.
- 4. Other side events will take place at the Vienna International Centre as follows:

#### **VISA REQUIREMENTS:**

6. A visa for entry into Austria may be required. Participants concerned are strongly advised to seek information on requirements applicable in their case from Austrian diplomatic or consular missions in their home countries. Participants who require a visa must contact the competent diplomatic or consular authorities of Austria and apply for a Schengen short-stay (C) visa at least three weeks prior to their intended date of arrival in Austria. In countries where Austria does not have diplomatic or consular representation, visa applications can be submitted to the consular authority of a State party to the Schengen Agreement acting on behalf of Austria in the country concerned.

## **HOTEL ACCOMMODATION:**

- 7. Vienna has a full range of hotels of different categories. The following provides options that participants can use to book their hotel rooms.
- i. Conference participants should make their booking directly by email as stated in the respective hotel information. Participants should book under the reference "United Nations LLDC Meeting" in order to get block booking rate. The hotels would need participant's credit card details and expiry date for the reservation. Free cancellation is possible until 72 hours prior the arrival. For late cancellation or No Show, 100 % will be charged from client credit card (mentioned on the booking form).
