

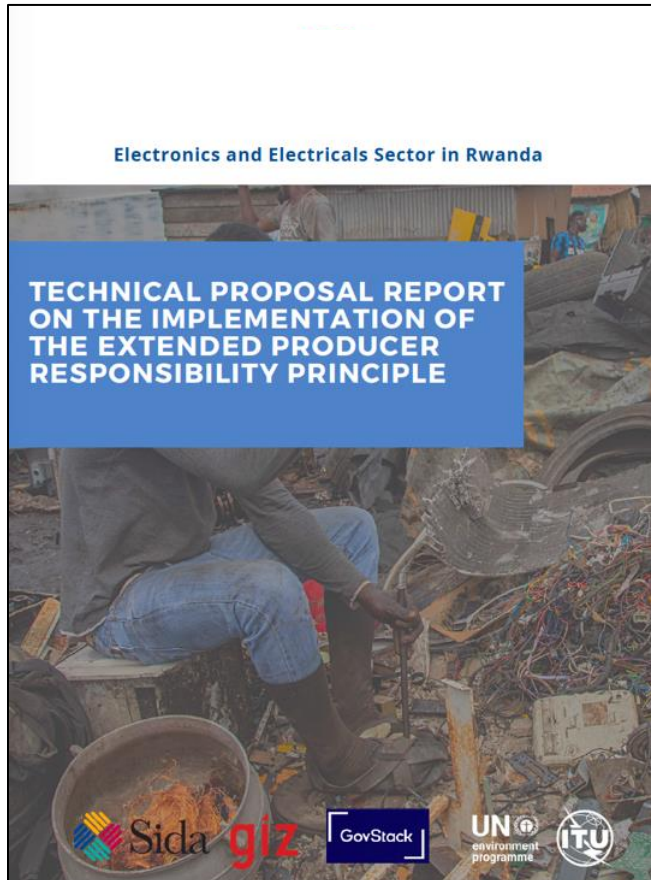
IMPLEMENTING EPR FOR ELECTRICALS AND ELECTRONICS IN RWANDA



Rwanda – Overview

- Led by the Government of Rwanda (RURA, MoE, RICA, REMA, RRA, RISA etc.).
- In collaboration with PSF, producers and recyclers.
- Objective to develop implementation steps for a legally transparent, digitally supported and appropriately financed EPR system for the management of e-waste in Rwanda.
- Focussing on 3 pillars: legal regime, administrative arrangements and financing mechanism for EPR in the electrical and electronics sectors.
- Founded on stakeholder consultation and senior management guidance.
- Based on Article 24 of RURA regulation on Governing E-waste Management.

Rwanda – Legal Regime



The legal regime is being analysed based on the existing and in-draft legal instruments with the objective to improve it and make it fit for purpose.

The 2 instruments under review are:

- Regulation N°002 of 26/4/2018 Governing E-waste Management;
- Regulation N° XX of XX Governing Electrical and Electronics Products.

Rwanda – Administrative Arrangements

- The project has analysed the existing import, product registration and business license procedures in Rwanda for EEE.
- The aim is to identify a simple and efficient registration process and EPR fee payment gateway for EEE producers.

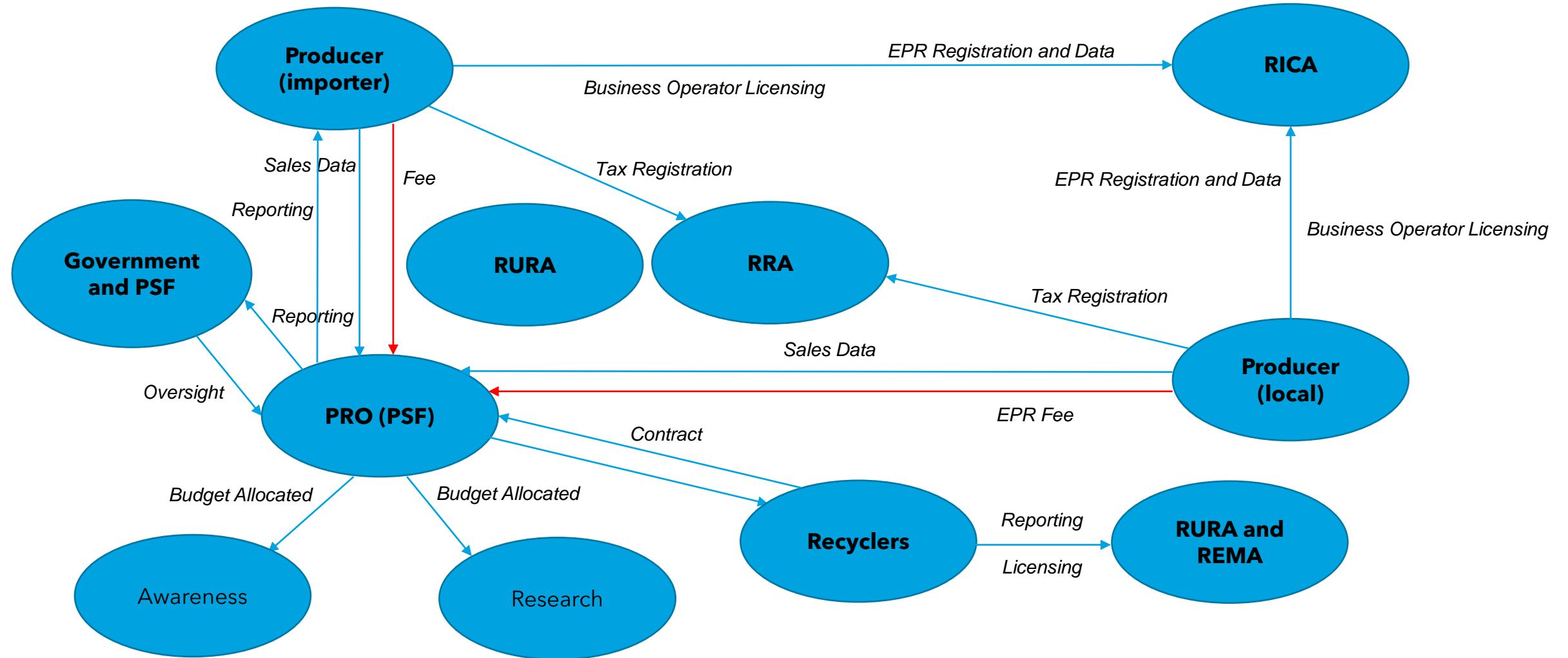

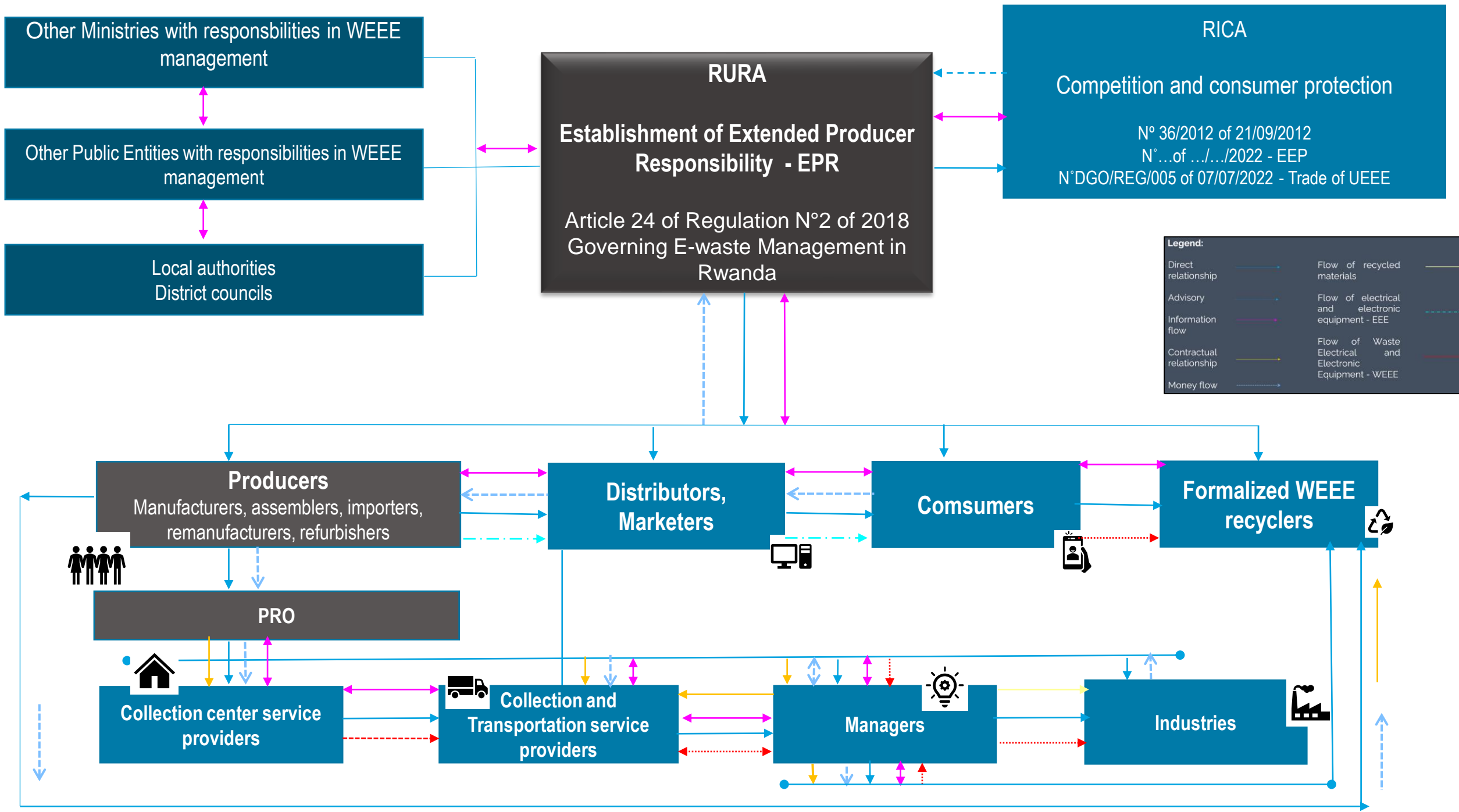

- Covering all six categories of EEE.
