



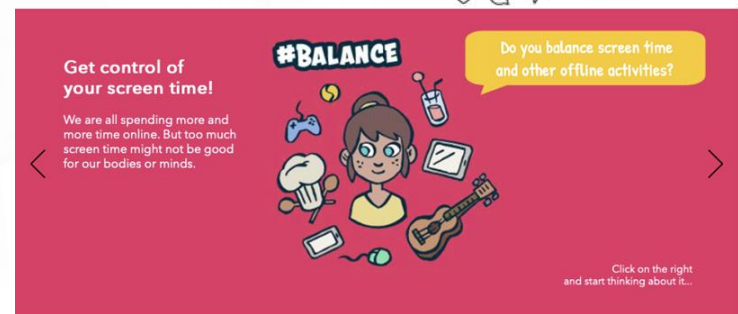
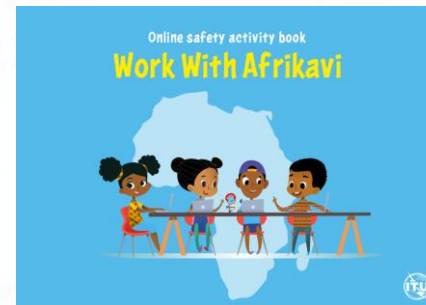
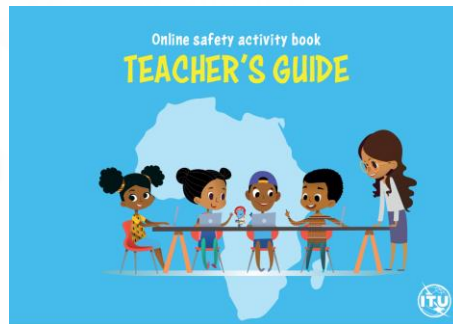
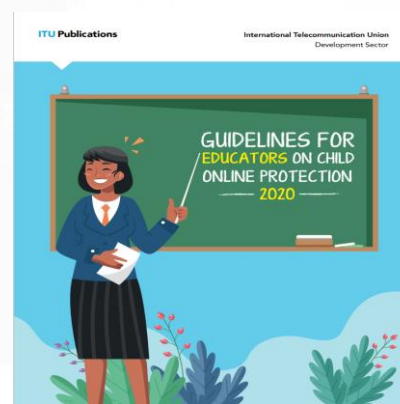
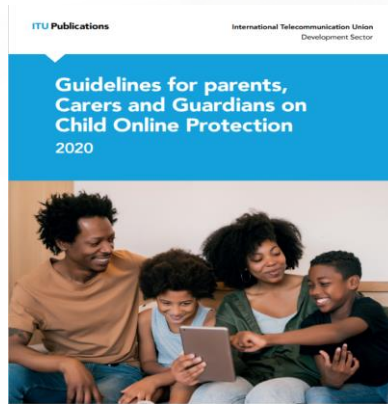
ITU-D Four-Year Rolling Operational Plan 2020 – 2023

We acknowledge the Challenges



- **Connectivity** :Many children don't have the means to connect with the outside world, nor benefit from the opportunities the Internet offers (learn, play, communicate, engage etc).
- **Digital Divide**: The digital divide goes beyond issues of connectivity, being strongly linked to digital skills and digital literacy of children and families.
- **Digital Transformation Gap**: Children must be granted access, skills, education and protection online.
- **Digital Skills & Literacy Gap** :Children need to be equipped and engaged in digital skills and digital literacy programs which include safety and protection measures.
- **The pandemic of COVID-19 shows the urgent need to action**: Children and young people spend more time online, so do online predators.
