2 How to travel to Ouagadougou in Burkina Faso

Airlines to/from Ouagadougou

The international airlines serving Ouagadougou are:

Algeria Airlines, Burkina Airlines, Colomb Airlines, Asky Airline, Air France, Côte D'Ivoire Airlines, Tunis Airlines, Turkish Airlines, Royal Marocco Airlines, Ethiopian Airlines.

Passport formalities

A valid passport is required for anyone travelling to Burkina Faso, except for citizens of ECOWAS countries for which a mere national identity card would suffice.

Customs clearance formalities

Visitors are allowed to enter Burkina Faso with four litres of alcohol. Personal items in reasonable quantities (cameras, watches, pens, lighters and cosmetics) may be imported tax-free. Other items are subject to customs duties (VCRs and other electronic products) to be cleared on site. Illicit drugs are not allowed into Burkina Faso.

3 Visas

All visitors must have a visa to enter Burkina Faso, except citizens of ECOWAS member countries.

ECOWAS

Citizens of the Economic Community of West African Countries (ECOWAS) and those of Chad, Cameroon and Morocco do not need a visa as long as their stay in Burkina Faso is less than three months (90 days), but they must present a valid passport (or national identity card) and return ticket.

Other countries

African citizens from non-ECOWAS member countries and those from non-African countries must have an entry visa issued by the diplomatic mission of Burkina Faso to their country of origin.

Obtaining a visa upon arrival

Delegates from any country can obtain a visa upon arrival at the Ouagadougou airport. They will be required to pay CFA 94,000 francs (approximately 171 USD) and present two photo ID. However, such persons shall inform the National Commission of Organization of their arrival at least one week beforehand.

4 Arrival in Ouagadougou

Welcome upon arrival

A reception and information desk will be set up at the Ouagadougou International Airport to facilitate arrival and departure procedures. Escort girls holding WAIGF panels will be on site.

5 How to move in Ouagadougou

Shuttle Service

For this event, a bus service will commute (morning and evening) between the airport and the hotels. Transportation means will also be arranged between these hotels and the venue.

Shuttle service is charge free.

8 Currency

The official currency is the franc of the African Financial Community (CFA). There are 10,000, 5,000, 2000, 1,000 and 500 CFA bank notess and 500, 250, 200, 100, 50, 25, 10, 5 and 1 CFA coins. Burkina Faso is part of the CFA Franc Zone.

You can change money at the airport and in the major hotels at about the following conversion rate.

Payment cards (credit/debit)

Diners Club, MasterCard and VISA cards are not accepted everywhere. It is useful to check with your bank to see if you can pay for purchases and other services with your card.

9 Health

All visitors must be in possession of a valid yellow fever vaccination certificate. It is recommended to be vaccinated against hepatitis and cholera. Since malaria is a widespread disease in Burkina Faso, it is advisable to take the necessary prophylactic measures.

Required vaccines:

- Yellow fever vaccine

Recommended vaccines:

- Hepatitis A and B vaccines
- diphtheria-tetanus-polio vaccine (**DT-polio**)
- Meningitis vaccine **A+C+Y+W135**

Participants are informed that a charge free first aid arrangement is available. A full time health service will be located at the venue. Hospitalization and evacuation shall be provided by the participants themselves at the following medical centres:

10 Time and Weather

Burkina Faso is on the Greenwich meridian, thus in the Universal Time (GMT).

Burkina Faso is in a tropical, warm and dry climate zone. There are two seasons: the dry season from November to April and the rainy season from May to October.

Harmattan, a very dry easterly wind, brings along a period of high heat from February to May, with temperatures between 30 and 40°C. The average annual rainfall is 115 cm (45 inches) in the southwest, but drops to 25 cm (10 inches) in the far north and the northeast. The rainy season lasts for four months in the northeast and six months in the southwest (from May to October).

11 Power

Power is supplied in 220 V CA, 50 Hz. The outlets are standard (two-pin).

12 Language

French is the official language in Burkina Faso, but 90% of the population speaks tribal languages of Sudanese origin. The most common local language is mooré, spoken by 55% of the population. The various ethnic groups speak their mother tongue.
