Mr. Bruno Pouezat (France) has been serving as UN Resident Coordinator and UNDP Resident Representative (UN RC/UNDP RR) for Jamaica, Bahamas, Bermuda, Turks and Caicos and the Cayman Islands since August 2015. From 2010-2015 he was UN RC/UNDP RR and UN Information Center Director for Morocco. He also served as UN RC/UNDP RR and UNFPA RR in Azerbaijan (2007-2010) and Moldova (2002-2007). In 2001-2002, M. Pouezat was Officer in Charge of UNDP Kuwait and in 1999-2001, he was the Special Assistant to the Associate Administrator, UNDP. M. Pouezat was Deputy Resident Representative in Mongolia (1994-1997) and worked as Assistant Resident Representative during the period 1991-1997 in Viet Nam, Somalia and Bangladesh. He was a Programme Officer in Uganda (1988-1990) and joined UNDP as a Junior Professional Officer in Mali (1986-1988). Before his career with UNDP, M. Pouezat was a Teaching Assistant at Harvard University and served with the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs as Deputy Scientific Attaché in the United States. M. Pouezat holds an M.Sc. in Soil Engineering from the University of Birmingham, UK, a Diplôme d'Ingénieur from the Ecole Supérieure des Travaux Publics, France and a Masters in Public Administration from Harvard University, USA.
